- KNOW WHO YOU ARE DEALING WITH VIA PHONE AND EMAIL
- SHRED ALL PRIVATE RECORDS & FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
- SECURE YOUR MAIL





Steps To Protect Your Identity

- NEVER LET CREDIT/DEBIT CARD OUT OF YOUR SIGHT
- IN ADDITION TO SIGNATURE, ADD "SEE PHOTO ID" ON CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS
- NEVER LEAVE ATM, CREDIT/DEBIT OR GAS STATION RECEIPTS BEHIND
- DESTROY ALL OF YOUR DIGITAL DATA





If Your ID Has Been Stolen

- CONTACT THE TOLL-FREE FRAUD NUMBER OF ANY 1 OF THE 3 CONSUMER REPORTING COMPANIES
- CONTACT SECURITY/FRAUD DEPARTMENT OF COMPANY WHERE FRAUD HAS OCCURRED
- CONTACT FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION ID THEFT HOTLINE 1-877- ID -THEFT
- CONTACT LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENT OR POLICE DEPARTMENT WHERE ID THEFT OCCURED
